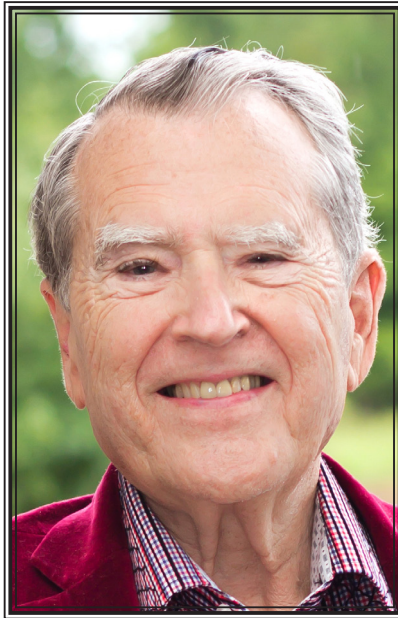

Our Preacher

R.T. Kendall is a Christian writer, speaker, and teacher who pastored Westminster Chapel for 25 years. He is the author of more than 50 books, including *Total Forgiveness*.

Rev. Dr. Kendall was born in Ashland, Kentucky and named after R. T. Williams who was a General Superintendent of the Church of the Nazarene. With his wife, Louise, he has a son and a daughter, Robert Tillman II and Melissa Louise, and three grandchildren.

He received degrees at Trevecca Nazarene University in Nashville, Tennessee, the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky and the University of



Louisville before earning a Doctor of Philosophy at Regent's Park College, a hall of the University of Oxford. He later received a Doctor of Divinity from Trevecca Nazarene University.

From 1977 to 2002 he was the Minister at Westminster Chapel in London.

Rev. Dr. Kendall is now in retirement in Hendersonville, Tennessee, from where he continues his work as an author and

guest speaker at Christian conferences. He appears on Christian TV programs and is a regular contributor to Christian publications. He is also the President of R.T. Kendall Ministries.

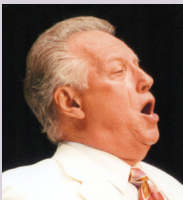
Rutter's exuberant Gloria has become revered by audiences and choirs alike.

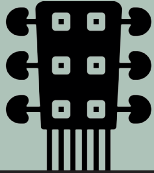

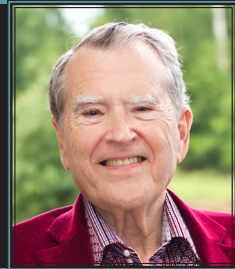
