Rev. Dr. DeForest B. Soaries, Jr. is the Senior Pastor of First Baptist Church of Lincoln Gardens in Somerset, New Jersey, former New Jersey Secretary of State, and the author of *Say Yes to No Debt: 12 Steps to Financial Freedom*.

He is the creator of dfree® – a financial freedom movement in use by thousands of churches and organizations across the country. dfree® has been featured by CNN in a 90-minute *Black in America* documentary entitled, “Almighty Debt.” His work has also been featured in several publications, including the *New York Times*, the *Wall Street Journal*, and *Black Enterprise*.

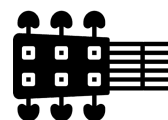
