## COLONELS KEN AND PAULA JOHNSON

Having both been born into the home of Salvation Army parents, it was clear that the Lord had plans for **Colonels Ken and Paula Johnson** at a very early age. Having committed their lives to Jesus, the Johnsons very quickly developed the zeal for service to others through the mission of The Salvation Army.

Upon their marriage in Charlotte, NC in 1981 the Johnsons entered The Salvation Army's College for Officers Training and were commissioned in 1984 as members of the Servants of God session. The Johnson's ministry path has been multi-faceted including two pastoral appointments in the Texas Division, returning to the College for Officers Training to serve on the faculty as the Business Administrator and Education Officer and then serving in various Divisional Headquarters staff positions across the Southern part of the USA in the business and program sections. Their leadership skills were later utilized as they were appointed as Divisional Leaders in the Georgia Division, the Texas Divisional and in the Florida Division. In 2018 Ken was appointed to the Southern Territorial Board of Trustees serving as the Secretary for Business Administration for all Salvation Army business activities in the 15 southern states and the District of Columbia. During this period Colo-



nel Paula served as the Assistant Chief Secretary for Mission Alignment.

In 2010 Ken and Paula embarked on international service serving as the Territorial Leaders for The Salvation Army's Eastern Europe Ter-

ritory. Based in Moscow, Russia, the Johnsons gave direction to the ministry of The Salvation Army in Russia, Ukraine, Moldova, Romania and the Republic of Georgia. During this time the Colonels served as members of The Salvation Army's High Council, the body of world leaders tasked with electing the worldwide General of The Salvation Army.

Upon their return to the USA in 2014, Ken and Paula were appointed to the staff of the USA East Territorial Headquarters in New York serving as the Territorial Chief Secretary and the Territorial Secretary for Women's Ministries respectively. Subsequently the Johnsons were appointed to The Salvation Army's National Headquarters where they serve as the National Chief Secretary and National Secretary for Personnel.

The real joy of their life are their two children: Christopher and Ashely and their four grandchildren, Ryan, Brooklyn, Kate and Harper.
