
Rev. Dr. Joseph Castleberry is President of Northwest University in Kirkland, Washington, a rigorously Christian university founded in 1934 that offers over 70 academic programs at bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels in residence

and online. He came to Northwest University in 2007 after serving as Academic Dean at the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary.

In addition to President Castleberry's work in higher education, he has been an ordained minister for over 30 years. He began his career as a chaplain at Princeton University, and for twenty years, served as a missionary in Latin America, where he planted and pastored several churches, taught in universities and seminaries, and led a community development project in an unreached people group.

President Castleberry is a graduate of Evangel University, Princeton Theological Seminary, and Columbia University. His latest book, *The New Pilgrims: How Immigrants are Renewing America's Faith and Values* addresses one of America's most pressing spiritual, social, and political issues.

President Castleberry has been married to his wife Kathleen since 1983. Their family includes three daughters, two sons-in-law, and a grandson. He enjoys golf, running marathons, visiting America's National Parks with his wife, and watching Northwest University sports.


