Our Preacher

Bishop Donald Hilliard, Jr. serves as the senior pastor of Cathedral International—The Historic Second Baptist Church in Perth Amboy, NJ. Dr. Hilliard's willingness to "Say Yes!" to the Lord has fostered his ability to provide leadership in the exponential growth of

the church over the last 35 years. Now, "One Church in Four Locations," Cathedral International has expanded its ministry to four different locations in New Jersey.

Dr. Hilliard's transformational mindset is reflected in the numerous community development initiatives established under his leadership. He is the Founder and CEO of the Cathedral Community Development Corporation (CCDC), an umbrella organization providing a variety of outreach services to the local community.

Dr. Hilliard is the author of 14 books on a variety of relevant topics. His most recent books are "Midlife, Manhood, & Ministry," and "55 and Counting."

Dr. Hilliard is also an artist and has expressed his gift of painting by releasing over 70 original pieces of art through his abstract expres-



sionistic company, Pulpit to the Palate Art. Dr. Hilliard's creativity does not stop with his gift of painting, but extends into the theatrical arts arena. In April 2013, Dr. Hilliard's first theatrical production, "Stop the Funeral" debuted in Rahway, NJ to a sold-out crowd. "Stop the Funeral" was written in an attempt

to create a sense of urgency of what we must do to change the mindset of the often misguided, misunderstood and sometimes forgotten youth, and has gained momentum as a movement to end senseless violence in our streets.

Dr. Hilliard earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Eastern College (now Eastern University), St. David's, Pennsylvania, the Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary, Princeton, NJ, and an earned Doctor of Ministry degree from United Theological Seminary, Dayton, Ohio, as a Dr. Samuel D. Proctor Fellow. He is also the recipient of various honorary doctoral degrees.

Dr. Hilliard partners in ministry with his wife, the Reverend Phyllis Thompson-Hilliard. They are the proud parents of three wonderful daughters, a son-in-law and an awesome grandson.
