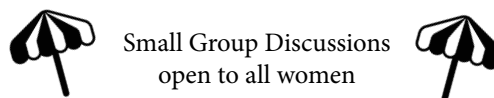

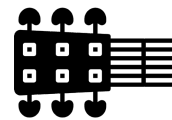

**Pastor Christian**

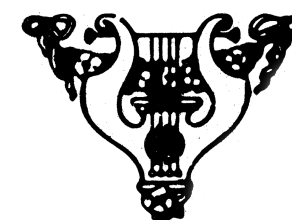
**Andrews** grew up
